JUDGMENT OF HUGH WILLIAMS, CJ



[1] Minute No.2 in this matter dated 31 October 2017 drew attention to Minute No.1 dated 11 August 2016, the latter of which drew attention to procedural deficiencies relating to the file.

[2] Minute No.2 dated 31 October 2017 advised the applicant that if the procedural difficulties were not corrected by 15 December 2017 the application would be dismissed for non-prosecution and as being procedurally incapable of being adjudicated upon.

[3] When the file was reviewed on 28 May 2018 it became clear that nothing further had been done in relation to the matter since the minute of 31 October 2017.

[4] The application is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution and as being procedurally incapable of being adjudicated upon.
