
[3] On 10 November 2008 the appellant's solicitors filed a Notice of Discontinuance, duly signed and consented to by the respondent, there to be no order as to costs.

[4] In the circumstances, we order that:

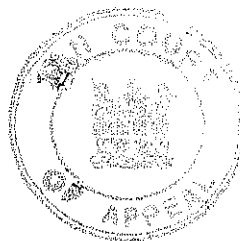
- (1) The appeal be dismissed.
