CUSTOMS ACT 1986

Customs (Prohibited Imports and Exports) (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations 2021

IN exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 64 of the Customs Act 1986, I hereby make these Regulations—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Prohibited Imports and Exports) (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations 2021.

(2) These Regulations come into force on 4 December 2021.

(3) In these Regulations, the Customs (Prohibited Imports and Exports) Regulations 1986 is referred to as the “Principal Regulations”.

Schedule 2 amended

2. Schedule 2 to the Principal Regulations is amended after item 20 by inserting the following new item—
