FIJIAN COMPETITION AND CONSUMER COMMISSION ACT 2010

**Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission
(Control of Prices for Ports Management Services)
Order 2024**

IN exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 39 of the Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission Act 2010 and on the recommendation of the Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission, I hereby make this Order—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission (Control of Prices for Ports Management Services) Order 2024.

(2) This Order comes into force on 29 March 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires “ports management services” means all services and facilities provided by a port, including—

- (a) marine service charges, wharfage, pilotage, dockage, container stevedoring, storage, anchorage, cargo or container handling and machine hiring charges, mooring, cleaning of wharf, fumigation, provision of water or electricity services, reefer charges or commissions;
- (b) other services relating to container and ship movement; and
- (c) facilities, including shops, office facilities and car parks.

Price control

3. For the purpose of section 39 of the Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission Act 2010, the prices or rates for the supply of all ports management services in Fiji are controlled.

Expiration of Order

4. This Order expires on 29 March 2027 unless the Order is varied, extended or revoked.
