PUBLIC SAFETY ACT

EXTENSION OF THE PUBLIC EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 2009

WHEREAS the Public Emergency Regulations 2009 were made pursuant to the Public Safety Act on 10th day of April 2009 and came into force for a period of 30 days at 1200 hours on that day; and

WHEREAS the Public Emergency Regulations 2009 were thereafter extended pursuant to the Public Safety Act for further periods of 30 days on 9th May 2009, 8th June 2009, 8th July 2009, 7th August, 6th September, 2009, 5th day of October, 2009, 4th November, 2009, 3rd December, 2009, 2nd January, 2010, 1st February 2010, 2nd March, 2010, 31st March, 2010, 29th April, 2010, 28th May, 2010, 27th June, 2010, 26th July, 2010, 24th August, 2010, 22nd September, 2010; 21st October, 2010, 19th November, 2010; 18th December, 2010, 16th January, 2011, 14th February, 2011, 15th March, 2011, 13th April, 2011, and 12th May, 2011.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Epeli Nailatikau, President of the Republic of Fiji, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of the Office of the President and Executive Authority Decree 2009, hereby extend the Public Emergency Regulations 2009 for a further period of 30 days with effect from 1200 hours on 10th June, 2011.
