Public Law No. 8 - 110

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 4-95, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-113, 5-14, 5-30, 5-44, 5-51, 5-82, 5-107, 5-131, 6-63 and 8-48, for the purpose of changing the use of funds previously appropriated for public projects in the Northern Namoneas region of Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-95, as amended by Public
2 Laws Nos. 4-113, 5-14, 5-30, 5-44, 5-51, 5-82, 5-107, 5-131, 6-63 and
3 8-48, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
