Law No 8-130

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 8-96 by amending sections 1, 11, and 13 to appropriate the sum of \$1,275,281 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, as supplemental funding for the executive branch, other National Government programs, grants, subsidies, contributions and refunds, and the development budget; to amend section 14 to raise the employment ceiling, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 8-96 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 "Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch. The sum of
4 \$14,927,499, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
5 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
6 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, for the
7 operations of the executive branch of the National Government of the
8 Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1995. Of the total
9 funds appropriated under this section \$566,065 shall be deemed to
10 come from the funds available under section 216(a)(1) of the Compact
11 of Free Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
12 apportioned as follows:

2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 13. Development budget - Appropriation. The sum of
4 \$5,028,248, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
5 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
6 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, for capital
7 improvement and development programs and projects of the
8 National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during
9 fiscal year 1995. The funds appropriated under subsection (1), (2)
10 and (3) of this section shall be deemed to come from the capital
11 account of the Compact of Free Association; PROVIDED,
12 however, that the funds appropriated under subsection (1) of this
13 section shall be used only for National Government Public Service
14 System employee staff upgrading and training programs not related
15 to or leading to academic programs or studies. The sum
16 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

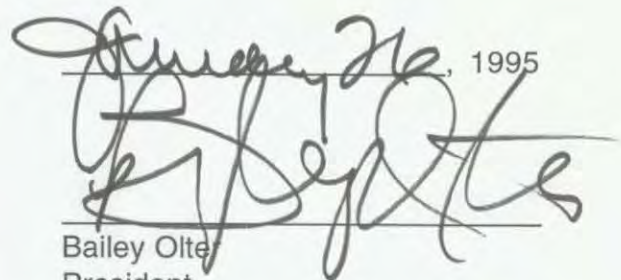

8 (2) The number of positions authorized applies
9 individually to each of the departments and offices of the executive and
10 legislative branches, the National judiciary, the Public Auditor, and to the
11 agencies as provided in subsection (1) of this section, except that the
12 President may transfer up to 12 positions between the departments and
13 offices of the executive branch. This authorization of positions covers all
14 permanent employees and all contract personnel whose employment
15 extends for more than 90 days. No funds may be expended for
16 unbudgeted positions."

17 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the
18 Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
