

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-49, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76, 17-06, 17-10, 17-23, 17-30, 17-32, 17-45, 17-82 and 17-85, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76, 17-06, 17-23, 17-30 and 17-32
3 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the sum of \$2,215,000 appropriated by
5 this act, \$1,080,000 is apportioned for Chuuk State for
6 public projects and social programs.

5 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended
6 by Public Laws Nos. 17-10, 17-45 and 17-85, is hereby amended
7 to read as follows:

8 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
9 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
10 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
11 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
12 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
13 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
14 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
15 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
16 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
17 appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under
18 sections 2 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
19 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
20 PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
21 section 4(1)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
22 Authority and the allottee of the funds appropriated
23 under section 4(1)(j) shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town
24 Government. The allottee of funds appropriated under
25 section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State.

1 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
2 5(1), 5(3) and 5(7) of this act shall be the Governor of
3 Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be
5 the Mortlock Islands Development Authority (MIDA). The
6 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of
7 this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
8 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
9 subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
10 Development Authority. The allottee of funds
11 appropriated under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be
12 the Northwest Development Authority. The funds
13 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
14 2014."

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25 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the

1 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
2 becoming law without such approval.
