PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-35

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$4,900,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$4,900,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
4 September 30, 2014, for the purpose funding public projects and
5 social programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk.
6 The funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as
7 follows:

8 Section 2. Of the sum of \$4,900,000 appropriated by this
9 act, \$700,000 is apportioned for public projects and social
10 programs in the State of Yap.

1 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
2 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
3 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,
4 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
5 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
6 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
7 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
8 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the
9 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
10 Governor of Yap State provided that the allottee of funds
11 appropriated under section 2(e) shall be the President of COM-FSM.
12 The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this
13 act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
14 or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated
15 under subsections (3)(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i),
16 (j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (p), (q), (r), (s), (t), (u), (v),
17 (w), (x) and (y) of section 3 of this act shall be the Mayor of
18 Lelu Town Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under
19 subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(e) of section 4 of this act
20 shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The allottee of
21 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of this act
22 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee
23 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be
24 the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
25 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the

1 Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds
2 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the
3 Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated
4 under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be the General Manager of
5 the Northwest Island Development Authority. The authority of the
6 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
7 September 30, 2015.

8 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
9 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
10 becoming law without such approval.
