PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-99

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$2,800,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the States of Kosrae, Chuuk, Pohnpei and Yap and, for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$2,800,000 is hereby appropriated
2 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
3 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015. The funds
4 appropriated under this section shall be used to fund public
5 projects and social programs for the people of the States of
6 Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk. The funds appropriated under
7 this section shall be apportioned in accordance with sections 2
8 through 5 below:

9 Section 2. Of the \$2,800,000 appropriated in this act,
10 \$400,000 is appropriated to fund public projects and social
11 programs for the people of the State of Yap.

21 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
22 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
23 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,
24 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
25 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these

1 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
2 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
3 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the
4 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
5 Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds
6 appropriated under section 3 shall be the President or his
7 designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
8 section 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j) (k), (l),
9 (m), (n) and (o) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government. The
10 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall
11 be the President or his designee, EXCEPT that the allottee of
12 funds appropriated under section 4(1)(a) shall be the Secretary of
13 the Department of Education; the allottee of funds appropriated
14 under section 4(1)(c), (e), and (h) shall be Secretary of the
15 Department of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure;
16 the allottee of funds appropriated under section section 4(1)(d)
17 shall be the Pohnpei Port Authority; the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under section 4(1)(f) shall be the Nett District
19 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under section
20 4(1)(g) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and
21 Development; the allottee of funds appropriated under section
22 4(2)(b) shall be the Mayor of Kapinga Municipal Government and the
23 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(3)(b) shall be the
24 Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The allottee of funds
25 appropriated under sections 5(1) and 5(3) of this act shall be the

1 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds
2 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the
3 Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the
5 Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the
7 Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated
8 under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be the General Manager of
9 the Northwest Island Development Authority. The authority of the
10 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
11 September 30, 2015.

12 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
13 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
14 becoming law without such approval.
