PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-135

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Law No. 19-125, in order to appropriate \$877,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017, to clarify certain line items and to modify their language to change their intended use, to divide one particular line item into two separate line items, to change the allottees for three line items, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended
2 by Public Law No. 19-125, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is as
5 follows: To appropriate the sum of \$70,677,981 from
6 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
7 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the
8 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of
9 the National Government of the Federated States of
10 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,
11 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human
12 Resources Development. The National Government's
13 share of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to
14 zero; EXCEPT THAT, the National Government will retain
15 10 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds
16 as is reflected in the budget for the Department of

1 Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be
2 apportioned as follows:"

3 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended
4 by Public Law No. 19-125, is hereby further amended to read as
5 follows:

6 "Section 2. Operating Expenses of the Executive Branch.
7 The sum of \$18,299,317 or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
9 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
10 year ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of
11 funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the
12 National Government during the fiscal year 2017. The
13 sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
14 follows:

11 Section 6. Section 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended
12 by Public Law No. 19-125, is hereby further amended to read as
13 follows:

14 "Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds
15 and Lapse Dates.

16 (1) General provisions.

17 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
18 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
19 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
20 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

21 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
22 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may
23 be necessary, are used solely for the purposes
24 specified in this act, and that no obligations are
25 incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.

1 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
2 appropriated by this act are as follows:

3 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds
4 shall be the President of the Federated States of
5 Micronesia;

6 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds
7 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
8 States of Micronesia;

9 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds
10 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia;

12 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds
13 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
14 Micronesia;

15 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee
16 of these funds shall be the President of the
17 Federated States of Micronesia; PROVIDED,
18 HOWEVER, that for the following subsections of
19 sections 8 through 9 of this act:

20 (i) Section 8(1)(g)(ii) - the
21 allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of
22 the Joint Committee on Compact Review and
23 Planning (JCRP);

24 (ii) Section 8(6)(g) - the allottee
25 shall be the President of the College of

1 Micronesia – FSM;

2 (iii) Section 8(6)(h) through (i) –
3 allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of
4 Chuuk State.

5 (iv) Section 8 (9)(a) through (v) –
6 the allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker
7 of the Congress of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia;

9 (v) Section 8(12)(a) through (d) –
10 the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief
11 Justice of the respective State Supreme Court;

12 (vi) Section 8(12)(o) – the allottee
13 of these funds shall be the Governor of the
14 respective States;

15 (vii) Section 8(12)(p) – the allottee
16 of these funds shall be the Governor of the
17 State of Yap;

18 (viii) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) –
19 the allottee of these funds shall be the
20 President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;

21 (ix) Section 9(4)(b) through (e) –
22 the allottee of these funds shall be the
23 Governor of the respective States;

24 (x) Section 9(12)(b) – the allottee
25 of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the

1 Chuuk State Supreme Court.

2 (xi) Section 9(12)(d) – the allottee
3 of these funds shall be the Speaker of the
4 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.

5 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the
6 allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this
7 act shall lapse as of September 30, 2017,
8 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds appropriated
9 under section 9 of this act shall not lapse.”

10 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
11 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
12 becoming law without such approval.
