

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61, 20-69, 20-90, 20-91, 20-96, 20-132, 21-92, 21-135 and 21-168, by amending sections 3 and 5 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the states of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61 and 20-91, is hereby further
3 amended, to read as follows:

4 "Section 3. Of the \$9,000,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$3,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority
6 infrastructure projects and other projects and programs
7 in the state of Pohnpei.

6 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by
 7 Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61, 20-91, 21-92, 21-135 and 21-168, is
 8 hereby further amended, to read as follows:

9 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 10 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 11 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 12 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 13 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 14 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 15 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 16 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
 17 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 18 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
 19 under sections 2 and 3 of this act shall be the
 20 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
 21 designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
 22 appropriated under subsections 2(a) to 2(af) and 2(ay)
 23 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government
 24 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
 25 under subsections 2(ag) to 2(a2) of this act shall be

1 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the
2 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
3 3(1)(a), 3(1)(b), 3(1)(c), 3(1)(e), 3(1)(g), 3(1)(j),
4 3(1)(p), 3(1)(r), 3(2)(b), 3(2)(c), 3(2)(d), 3(2)(e),
5 3(2)(o), 3(3)(d), 3(3)(n), 3(3)(t) and 3(3)(x) of this
6 act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the
7 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
8 3(3)(f), 3(3)(l) and 3(3)(m) of this act shall be the
9 Lukenmoanlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds
10 appropriated under subsections 3(3)(q) and 3(3)(r) of
11 this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation; the
12 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
13 4(1) and 4(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
14 State or his designee; the allottee of the funds
15 appropriated under subsection 4(2) of this act shall be
16 the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the
17 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3) of
18 this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government
19 or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated
20 under subsection 4(4) of this act shall be the Southern
21 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the
22 funds appropriated under subsection 4(5) of this act
23 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority; the allottee
24 of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(7) of this
25 act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or

1 his designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate
2 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
3 30, 2022.”

4 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
5 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
6 becoming law without such approval.
