CONGRESSIONAL BILL No. 4-320, C.D.1, C.D.2,

## AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$6,637,488 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia and the sum of \$5,759,889 from the United States Grant Special Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, National judiciary, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, contributions, grants, subsidies, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1987; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch. The sum  
2 of \$1,346,098, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby  
3 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of  
4 Micronesia and the sum of \$5,759,889, or so much thereof as may be  
5 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the United States Grant  
6 Special Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for the  
7 operations of the executive branch of the National Government of the  
8 Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1987. The sums  
9 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

18           (2) The number of positions authorized applies individually  
19 to each of the departments and offices of the executive and legislative  
20 branches, the National judiciary, the Public Auditor, and to the agencies  
21 as provided in subsection (1) of this section, except that the President  
22 may transfer up to 12 positions between the departments and offices of  
23 the executive branch. This authorization of positions covers all permanent  
24 employees, all contract personnel whose employment extends for 1 year  
25 or more, and all positions funded from United States federal programs.

1 No funds may be expended for unbudgeted positions.

2 Section 8. Reprogramming.

3 (1) The President or his designee may reprogram up to 10  
4 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of the subsections  
5 in section 1, and may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds  
6 appropriated in each of the paragraphs within the subsections of section 1.

7 (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10  
8 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of the subsections  
9 in section 2, and may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds  
10 appropriated in each of the paragraphs within the subsections of section 2.

11 (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up  
12 to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each of the sub-  
13 sections in section 3.

14 (4) The Public Auditor may reprogram up to 15 percent to  
15 and from the funds appropriated in each of the subsections in section 4.

16 (5) Allottees of funds may reprogram up to 15 percent to  
17 and from the funds appropriated in each of the paragraphs within the  
18 subsections of section 5.

19 Section 9. Change in Fund structure. If prior to the lapsing of the  
20 appropriations under this act, the United States Grant Special Fund  
21 is abolished and all moneys then in the Fund are transferred to the  
22 General Fund, then the appropriations made in this act from the United  
23 States Grant Special Fund shall be deemed to be made from the General  
24 Fund as successor to the United States Grant Special Fund.

25 Section 10. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.

1 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,  
2 administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law,  
3 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979,  
4 as amended. Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that  
5 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely  
6 for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are  
7 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. No funds provided by  
8 subsections (8) and (9) of section 6 of this act may be obligated  
9 until the National Government obtains either title to the land on  
10 which the buildings are to be constructed or a leasehold interest to  
11 the land on which the buildings are to be constructed of a duration  
12 equal to the useful life of the buildings. The authority of the  
13 allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as  
14 of September 30, 1987.

15 Section 11. Effective date. This act shall become law upon  
16 approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or  
17 upon its becoming law without such approval.
