

AN ACT

To amend section 2 of Public Law No. 4-95 for the purpose of reallocating funds for certain public projects in the Faichuk area, and to amend subsection (3)(c)(iv)i) to change the purpose of an appropriation for Inaka, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
