The Citizenship Act 1984, 43 MIRC, Chapter 4, Section 410(2) is hereby amended to 14 read as follows: 15 "(2) In a case where any person applies for citizenship by registration under 16 Article XI, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Marshall Islands, the Cabinet 17 shall, within such time as may be prescribed by the High Court, submit to that 18 19 Court a certificate stating whether in the opinion of the Cabinet such person is a 20 fit and proper person to be registered as a citizen in the interests of national 21 security; provided however, that the Cabinet may delegate its power under this 22 Section to the Minister who shall submit the required certificate to the Court. A certificate under the hand of the Cabinet, or the Minister as the case may be, shall 23 24 be conclusive proof of the matters therein stated and shall not be called in

question in any court whether by way of writ or otherwise."
