AN ACT to repeal the "Duty Free Concessions Act" as set out under 20 MIRC Chapter 5 (the Act); to cancel all duty free licenses issued thereunder; and to prohibit the operation of duty free concession shops until Cabinet has conducted a thorough review of the matter. BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS Section 1. **Short Title** This Act may be cited as the Duty Free Concessions (Repeal) Act, 2004. Section 2. Interpretation In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires; "person (s)" means an individual, company, corporation, association, or (a) other business entity. Repeal and Cancellation of Licenses Section 3. The Duty Free Concessions Act, as set out under 20 MIRC Chapter 5 is hereby (1) repealed.
