AN ACT

1	to provide;
2	(a) in accordance with Article VIII, Section 8 of the Constitution for a Supplemental
3	Appropriation, from the Marshall Islands General Fund, from funds obtained as Asian Development
4	Bank loans in the total amount of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) and funds provided as grants by the
5	European Union in the amount of four million, six hundred thousand Euros (Eu 4,600,000); to meet
6	certain special appropriations and capital expenditures of the Government as set out in Schedules 1 and
7	2 below.
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8 9	(b) for delegation of approved expenditure under Section 5 of Article VIII of the Constitution;
9	and
10	(c) for controls on reprogramming and transfer of funds within program areas.
11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS:
12	Section 1. Short Title.
13	This Act may be cited as the Financial Year 2003 Supplemental Appropriation Act, 2003.
14	Section 2. Statement of National Objective.
15	It is the intention of the Government of the Republic of the Marshall Islands to hereby enact
16	and implement a supplemental appropriation, to authorize certain special appropriations and capital
17	expenditures over and above that authorized by the P.L. 2002-60, in the manner set out in Schedules
18	1 and 2 below.
19	Section 3. Interpretation.
20	In this Act unless the context otherwise requires;

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(1) "program area" means the program areas set out in Schedule 1 below.

	Section 4. Appropriation from the Marshall Islands General Fund.
3	The sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000), being the total amount of loan proceeds from
4	the Asian Development Bank, and the sum of Four million, six hundred thousand Euros (Eu
5	4,600,000) being the amount of grants from the European Union, are hereby appropriated and may
6	be withdrawn from the Marshall Islands General Fund pursuant to Article VIII of the Constitution, as
7	special appropriations and capital expenditures for the projects and program areas as set out in
8	Schedules 1 and 2 below.
9	Section 5. Lapsing of Funds
10	The appropriations made under Section 4 herein shall not lapse at the end of the Financial
11	year 2003 but shall continue until either;
12	(a) the purposes of the appropriation are satisfied, or
13	(b) the funds are expended,
14	whichever occurs first, as set out in Schedules 1 and 2 below.
15	Section 6. Delegation of Authority.
16	(1) For the purpose of Article VIII, Section 5(1) of the Constitution, the authority to approve
17	expenditure in a program area in accordance with Schedule 1, is hereby delegated to:-
18	(a) the member of Cabinet primarily responsible for that program area; and
19	(b) if the responsible member of Cabinet so directs by instrument in writing, and

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2	subject to any limitations imposed by the instrument and to general control by the member,
3	the appropriate person, authority, or agency, subject in either case to any limitations imposed
4	by the Cabinet.
5	(2) Any expenditure otherwise than in accordance with Schedules 1 and 2 below shall require
6	the approval of the Cabinet in accordance with Article VIII, Section 5 of the Constitution.
7	Section 7. Budget Estimates.
8	Budget estimates for expenditures for the relevant program areas are as set forth in Schedules
9	1 and 2 below.
10	Section 8. Reprogramming and Transfers
11	No funds may be reprogrammed or transferred to any other program areas or disbursed in any
12	other manner except as set out in Schedules 1 and 2 below.
13	Section 9. Effective Date.
14	This Act shall come into effect on the date of certification in accordance with Article IV,
15	Section 21 of the Constitution.
