10	This Act may be cited as the Protection of Resident Workers (Amendment) Act, 2004	
11	Section 2. Amendments	
12	The following provisions are hereby inserted under Section 104 of the Act, to read as	
13	follows;	
14	§104. Preference	
15	Notwithstanding any other law or regulation to the contrary, each employer in the	
16	Republic shall be required, unless exempted by order of the President, to:	
17	(a) maintain by the commencement of its second year of its operations, a	
18	workforce, at least twenty-five per cent (25%) of which is comprised of resident workers	;
19	(b) maintain by the commencement of its third year of operations, a workforce	
20	that is fifty per cent (50%) of which is comprised of resident workers;	
21	(c) maintain by the commencement of its fourth year of operations and for every	
22	year of operations thereafter, a workforce at least seventy-five per cent (75%) of which is	;

2	(d) employ by the commencement of its second year of operations, thereafter, at
3	least one Marshallese citizen to train as a counter-part to each non-resident worker
4	employed at such time.
5	(e) In addition to the foregoing requirements, resident workers shall at all times be
6	given preference in employment in the Republic.
7	(2) Non-residential workers shall be employed only to supplement the labor force of
8	available and qualified resident workers, and shall not be paid a higher salary or wage than
9	equally qualified resident workers performing the same type of job in any industry or occupation,
10	No employer shall employ a nonresident worker except in strict compliance with the provisions
11	of this chapter and the Rules and Regulations issued hereunder, except that the provisions of this
12	chapter shall not apply to temporary employees who are brought into the Republic for a period
13	not to exceed ninety (90) days. If the employer bringing in such temporary employees to the
14	Republic finds that the services are needed for a period of time exceeding the ninety (90) days, he
15	may apply to the Secretary for the extension of the exemption and the Secretary may grant such
16	extension of the exemption if he finds that the extension is reasonable. The Secretary may grant
17	more than one extension, bu the total time period, including any extensions, that a temporary
18	employee may remain in the Republic under temporary employee status shall not exceed one
19	hundred and eighty (180) days. Prior to the issuing of an exemption, the Secretary shall confirm
20	that the Ministry of Justice has issued the nonresident worker a valid visa or entry permit for the

	under the visa or work permit.

	Section 4. Effective Date
