An Act

To amend Traditional Rights Court (Composition and Appointments) Act, 27 MIRC, Chapter 3, as amended by Part II of the Judiciary (Amendment) Act of 1995, P.L. 1995 - 135, to equate the tenure of office of the Chief Judge and Associate Judges of the Traditional Rights Court to that of a judge of the superior courts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS:

Section 1. Short Title.

This Act may be cited as the Traditional Rights Court (Composition and Appointments) (Amendment) Act, 2000.

Section 2. Amendment.

Section 3 of the Traditional Rights Court (Composition and Appointments) Act, 27 MIRC, Chapter 3, as amended, is further amended as follows:

(1) by inserting immediately after Subsection (1), the following:

“(2) The Chief Judge and Associate Judges appointed under Subsection (1) shall hold office during good behavior until reaching the age 72 years.” and

(2) by renumbering Subsection (2) as Subsection (3).


