THE REPUBLIC v JUANITA IKA

JUDGMENT

Accused is a married lady with a child. She is a first offender for this offence though convicted for speeding 11 years back. She has come out with a clean plea of guilty with regrets for his conduct. She assures that she would not give room for such a thing with this background. The accused being a first offender, a lady with a child (married) with the regrets for her conduct, I am inclined to deviate from awarding the normal sentence and accordingly I convict the accused for the offence contrary to section 21 (1) of the Motor Traffic Act and I sentence her to pay a fine of \$150 i.d. two months hard labour.

Further her driving licence is suspended in a period of six months from this day.
