THE REPUBLIC v DAVID DENGGA

JUDGMENT

Accused has come out with a clear plea of guilty. He has no previous history or convictions. He is 25 years old and working at N.P.C. in phosphate digging. He regrets for his conduct and assures he would not indulge himself in any such way. There is one more case in Criminal Case No. 373/80 with similar charge where he has also pleaded guilty. That offence is on 3rd July earlier to this.

With the background as above though the accused appears to have repented for his conduct with the repeated offence he has committed it calls for appropriate sentence. With these remarks, I accept the plea of guilty of accused which is a voluntary one made knowing the consequences of the plea. I sentence him to one months imprisonment with hard labour

Further his driving licence is suspended for a period of six months.
