THE REPUBLIC v SWANA MURDOCK

JUDGMENT

Accused, knowing the consequences of his plea, has come out with a clear plea of guilty. He is no first offender for drinking under age and who is still undergoing sentenc. He had been fined \$100 for speeding just two months back with a warning. He appears to be a talented young man who is just flirting away his time and energy on such things, though he had been employed in N.P.C. prior to his previous conviction. Anyway I am influenced by his regrets for his acts. He is a first offender on count 1.of the charge.

With these observations, I convict the accused on both the counts of the charge and sentence him to one months imprisonment on each of the two counts. Further, his driving licence is suspended for a period of six months from this date.
