JUDGMENT

This was quite a serious case of driving under the influence of intoxicating liquor. It is not one of those comparatively rare cases where a fine is adequate. The sentence of the fine of \$50 is set aside and a sentence of one month's imprisonment is imposed in its place. The respondent's driving licence is suspended for 6 months from the date of his conviction.
