**ORDER OF DONNE C.J.**

---


Both accused are convicted and are remanded for sentence to 1/7/99  
subject to the following conditions:

- (a) They attend the Courthouse on the Monday and Wednesday of each and every week and, report to the Clerk of Court Mr. Notte.

- (b) The time of reporting should be 3 p.m.
- (c) They should do cleaning work on all Court cars, staff or office, to the satisfaction of Mr. Notte.
- (d) They shall remain on duty at the Courthouse until discharged by Mr. Notte.
- (e) Mr. Notte has the complete control of the accused while so engaged at the work and may vary the days of attendance, but for not more than 2 days in each week. Mr. Notte may, in his discretion excuse the offenders from attending on any day.

COPY

- (f) Subject to satisfactory performance of the above conditions, the offenders shall be discharged on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 1999.
- (g) Should either offender fail to attend as ordered or fail to work to the satisfaction of Mr. Notte, he should be brought before the Court for sentence at any time before the 1<sup>st</sup> April.
- (h) The Magistrate may properly discharge the offenders, but, if a sentence is to be imposed, the offender concerned shall be remanded for sentence by the Judge of the next Sessions.
