

ORDER

---

1. Following the decision dismissing the claim against Liu Simon in the action *Zho Ye Quo v Xing Xiao, Liu Simon and Liu Luk Quien*, my order dated 18 February 2005 restraining Liu Simon from leaving Nauru is discharged.
2. It should be noted that orders against Xing Xiao and Liu Luk Quien both dated 29<sup>th</sup> September 2004 are not discharged and remain in place. The Court has reason to believe that both the above named have absconded unlawfully from the jurisdiction and are in contempt.
3. Authorities, police and immigration, should note the above.
