## REPUBLIC OF NAURU

(No. 8 of 1992)

#### AN ACT

To provide for withdrawal and expenditure of moneys from the Treasury Fund and Nauru Housing Fund to meet the expenditure of the Republic during the Financial Year ending on the 30th day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Three.

(Certified: 18th September, 1992)

Be it enacted by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:

#### SHORT TITLE:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1992 - 1993.

#### INTERPRETATION:

#### 2. In this Act

"estimates" means the estimates of revenues and expenditures of Nauru for the financial year prepared and laid before the Parliament in pursuance of Article 59(4) of the Constitution;

"the financial year" means the year commencing on the 1st day of July, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-two and ending on the 30th day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-three, inclusive of both such dates;

"head" means a department or division of the expenditure of the Republic listed in the Schedule of this Act;

"subhead" means a sub-division of a head appearing in the estimates.

#### **AUTHORISATION OF EXPENDITURE:**

- 3. (1) During the financial year there may be withdrawn from the Treasury Fund sums not exceeding in aggregate the sum of ONE HUNDRED TWELVE MILLION THREE HUNDRED THIRTY FIVE THOUSAND AND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS ONLY (\$112,335,700) as authorised in the Schedule to this Act in accordance with the estimates.
- (2) Where the Cabinet considers it necessary to increase the amount assigned in the estimates to a particular subhead within a head, the Cabinet may direct that there shall be applied to the aid of that subhead a further sum out of any surplus arising on any other subhead within the same head, but so that the total amount withdrawn and expended does not exceed the amount authorised for that head in the Schedule to this Act;

provided that where the Cabinet authorises a transfer of funds between subheads within a head in accordance with this sub-section it be shall cause to laid before the Parliament, first meeting of at the after it has approved the Parliament transfer, a copy of the Order of the Cabinet approving such transfer.

### NAURU HOUSING FUND:

4. Where moneys are withdrawn from the Treasury Fundand expended as authorised by this Act and in accordance with the estimates for erection, maintenance or repair of Nauruan Housing, the Treasury Fund shall be reimbursed from the Nauru Housing Fund to the extent of that expenditure and there may be withdrawn from the Nauru Housing Fund such sum or sums as is necessary to effect such reimbursement.

#### INCOME FROM NAURUAN HOUSING:

5. All deposits, purchase moneys, rentals, interest and other moneys paid in respect of the erection, maintenance or repair of Nauruan Housing provided in accordance with the expenditure authorised by section 4 or the disposal of any assets acquired in connection therewith, shall be paid to the Nauru Housing Fund.
