UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII

SCHOLARSHIP

The University of Hawaii provides courses at degree and diploma level in a large number of subjects for persons all over the world. The University is considering offering to Nauru two places which may be filled by suitably qualified and interested Nauruans.

The academic year starts in mid-September and courses are usually of two years initially for Diploma Status, with a further two years leading to a University degree.

Education fees, accommodation, travelling grants and pocket money are all provided by the University.

In order to enable Nauruans to avail themselves of this scholarship this year, applications from interested Nauruans should be lodged with the Secretary of Health and Education no later than June 7, 1968. Applications must contain the following information:

- (a) Full name.
- (b) Age and marital status.
- (c) Highest qualification held and year of completion.
- (d) Present position (inside or outside the Public Service).
- (e) Positions held over the last two years.
- (f) The type of course the applicant would prefer to study.
- (g) Any overseas study previously attempted and the result of that study. Also indicate at which particular institution the study was carried out.

NOTE:

All applications will be considered on their merits and the final selection of suitable candidates will be carried out by a personal interview with a Selection Committee.
