CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

APPOINTMENT BY CABINET UNDER ARTICLE 21

IN EXERCISE of the powers in that behalf in it vested in it under Article 21 of the Constitution of Nauru, CABINET HEREBY APPOINTS THE HONOURABLE AUSTIN BERNICKE, being the Minister for Health and Education and a Member of the Parliament of Nauru, to perform the duties and exercise the functions of the President during the period of absence from the Republic of His Excellency President Hammer DeRoburt, O.B.E., M.P.

CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER ARTICLE 23

Acting President

The portfolios of Health and Education, External Affairs and Internal Affairs.

Minister for Justice

The portfolio of Island Development and Industry.

Minister for Finance

The portfolio of Works and Community Services.

The above assignments of responsibility for the business of the Government of Nauru shall be effective during the absence from the Republic of His Excellency President Hammer DeRoburt, O.B.E., M.P. and the Honourable Buraro Detudamo, M.P.
