LIQUOR ORDINANCE 1967

(SECTION 22 AND 24)

APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF LICENCE

Notice is hereby given that the following application for the RENEWAL of a LIQUOR RETAILERS' LICENCE has been lodged with me :

This application will be considered at a hearing of the Liquor Licensing Board which has been set down for 10.00 a.m. on Friday 24 March 1978 at the office of the Chief Secretary, Government Buildings, Yaren.

Objections based upon a substantial ground may be raised at the hearing of any applications by :

- (a) a Licensing Inspector;
- (b) the Government Medical Officer; or
- (c) jointly, by three or more persons over the age of twenty-one years.

A person who desires to make an objection at the hearing of an application shall lodge with the Registrar a notice of objection stating his full name and address and the grounds upon which the objection is made and shall serve a copy of the notice upon the applicant within twenty-four hours from the time of lodgement.
