1. Position: Executive Officer
 Salary: \$9032-\$10472 (AP6/7.)
 Duties: Responsible to the Director of Health & Medical Service for the Dispensary, Personnel matters, Travel arrangements, Accounting, Stores Control including Ordering, Departmental Motor Transport, Building Maintenance.
 Qualifications: Extensive experience in Hospital Administration preferably with a recognised Diploma or Certificate in the field.
 Preference will be given to applicants with Pharmacy qualifications and if the appointee is a qualified Pharmacist a higher salary as negotiated may be paid.
2. Position: Stenographer/ Secretaries (6 positions)
 Salary: \$4976-\$5636 (C2/3.)
 Duties: To provide secretarial and administrative duties to Heads of Departments in the Public Service of the Republic.
 Qualifications: Shorthand speed of 80 W.P.M. and minimum typing speed of 50 W.P.M. Steno/Secretary experience essential.
3. Position: Senior Laboratory Technologist
 Salary: \$6668-\$8000 (T7/9.)

4. The provision of Public Health Laboratory Services including the Biological and Chemical analysis of Water and Food.
5. The Laboratory is well equipped and includes Spectrophotometer, EEL Chemical Flame Photometer and modern Wild Microscopy equipment.

Qualifications:

Applicant should hold at least Associate Status in the Institute of Laboratory Technologists or equivalent standing and have had several years practical experience in a medical laboratory including work on Haematology, Bacteriology, Serology, Biochemistry and Parasitology. Experience in a tropical situation would be advantageous.

Duties:

Directly responsible to the Director of Works for the control and supervision of the Department's drafting office, the drafting staff and the training of junior staff. Other responsibilities include technical library, filing systems and plan printing facilities, the preparation of technical reports on project, the checking and approving of work submitted by itinerant architects and such other tasks as may be required by the Director of Works from time to time.

A sound knowledge of architectural and engineering drafting is required.

5. Position:

Duties:

As Head of the Department of Finance, he is required to supervise revenue collection and the control of expenditure by all departments of the Republic government to ensure adequate recording of all financial transactions and to prepare periodic statements. He will be directly responsible for the administration of the Department of Finance and will advise the Minister for Finance and through him the Cabinet on all aspects of public finance. The Secretary for Finance is also responsible for the postal services of the Republic.

Qualifications: Ideally, applicants should possess a good honours degree in economics. A qualifications in accounting and or a sound background in this field would be an added advantage. Candidates should have experience in government or quasi-government and in commercial finance, preferably internationally.

6. Position: Chief Accountant

Salary: \$10,952-\$12,032 p.a. (S1.)

Duties: Responsible to the Secretary for Finance for the effective control of all accounting and related operations in the Treasury Department including Treasury budgetary control of revenue and expenditures of Government departments. Costing of Government projects and stores accounting and such other assignments as may be from time to time directed by the Secretary for Finance.

Qualifications: Several years experience at a senior level in the Treasury Department of an overseas Government is an essential requirement with a proven record of success in the field of treasury work. A recognised professional accounting qualification would be an advantage.
