SECTION 27(2) - NAURUAN BASIC WAGE

IN EXERCISE of the powers vested in me under Section 27(2) of the Public Service Act 1961 - 1979, I, BURARO DETUDAMO Minister Responsible for the Public Service, HEREBY ADVISE THAT the reviews have been carried out on the Retail Price Index of Commodities and HEREBY DETERMINE that the following basic wage rates shall take effect from the 19th November, 1982 which is the-first local pay day following the 15 November, 1982.

Adult	- \$ 4923.00 p.a.
20 Years of Age (90%)	- \$ 4431.00 p.a.
19 Years of Age (70%)	- \$ 3446.00 p.a.
18 Years of Age (60%)	- \$ 2954.00 p.a.
17 Years of Age (55%)	- \$ 2708.00 p.a.
16 Years of Age (50%)	- \$ 2462.00 p.a.

POSITION: Deputy Principal, Nauru Secondary School

SALARY: \$9088.00 p.a. (fixed at 3rd Point AP5)

- DUTIES:
1. To assist the Principal in running the School in both administrative and professional aspects, including the following particular responsibilities:
 - (a) to be incharge of school assemblies and the movement of pupils between classrooms,
 - (b) oversight of teachers' playground and bus duties,
 - (c) guidance to school prefects,
 - (d) day-to-day oversight of the work of the Liaison Officer,
 - (e) follow-up of late students and absentees,
 - (f) when requested by teachers, provide assistance with disciplinary matters,
 - (g) arrange relief teachers when required and take a class when no reliever available,
 - (h) help the Principal in the preparation of annual estimates and in implementing the approved budget,
 - (i) control school stationery supplies,
 - (j) oversight of inventory records throughout the school.
 2. To carry a teaching load of approximately 12 periods per six-day cycle.
 3. To take the place of the Principal in his absence.
