Arrange for parents/guardians to dispatch sums direct to school/institution through the bank and then record details on local files and inform Melbourne Office.

In an emergency, arrange for the parent/guardian to pay cash into Treasury and then advise Melbourne office authorising payment.

(i) whenever possible, parents/guardians should send money personally through the bank;
