NOMINATIONS FOR PARLIAMENTARY GENERAL ELECTION

(18TH NOVEMBER, 1995)

IT IS NOTIFIED for the information of the general public and particularly the intending candidates for Election to membership of the 12th Parliament of Nauru that:-

- a) Nominations can validly be made only after the Rolls have been closed for each District, (i.e., after Saturday, 28th October, 1995) and on or before Nomination Day (i.e., on or before Saturday, 4th November, 1995).
- b) Nomination papers may be handed to the Returning Officer at Chief Secretary's Office during Public Service hours, from Monday, 30th October, 1995 to Friday, 3rd November, 1995. To assist the intending candidates, the Returning Officer will also be available in his Office (in the room next to the Cabinet Room in the Administration Building) on those days. Nomination will close at 1:00 pm on Saturday, 4th November, 1995.
- c) Nomination must be made in Form 6 of the Schedule to the Electoral Act 1965-1992 and signed by (i) at least two Electors who are on the Roll for the Electoral District concerned (i.e., the District in which the candidate intends to stand for election); and (ii) by the candidate. The intending candidate must also be an Elector whose name is on the Roll for the Electoral District concerned. No nominations shall be valid unless they comply with the requirements of law.
- d) Nomination Forms are available from the Chief Secretary's Office.
- e) Candidates who have been duly nominated, but wishing to withdraw their candidature may do so by notice in writing signed by them to the Returning Officer not later than 4:30 pm on Saturday, 11th November, 1995.
