10. Organise activities, tours or trips for students during holidays.
11. Ensure all passports and visas are in proper order and attend to any visa or passport extension needs.
12. Be available for student emergency situations.
13. Submit monthly update reports on the progress and status of all students within your area.
14. Attend parent teacher meetings for school or orientation programs and education related functions.
