Criminal trials or appeals in each sitting will be given preference to civil matters. Urgent applications outside of sitting periods may be dealt with in the Chief justice's Chambers in Melbourne.

At a Call-over of the list, only those cases ready for trial will be listed at the sittings.

Public Service and Nauru Police Appeal Boards will sit as required and normally in the last week of the Supreme Court Sittings.
