SUPREME COURT OF NAURU
PRACTICE NOTE No. 1 OF 2005

APPLICATIONS FOR BAIL IN THE SUPREME COURT

1. Any applications for bail in the Supreme Court must be filed with the Registrar.
2. When filed on behalf of an applicant by a legal representative, that is a barrister and solicitor or pleader, the application must be accompanied by an affidavit setting out the fact to be relied upon in support of the application and a copy of the application and of the affidavit must be served on the Director of Public Prosecutions on the day they are filed with the Registrar.
3. When filed on behalf of an applicant in person the application must set out the grounds of the application and the Registrar must promptly supply the Director of Public Prosecutions with a copy of the application and of the affidavit (if any) in support.
4. The application must not specify any date for the hearing
5. (a) On receipt of the documents the Director of Public Prosecutions should promptly prepare any material to be submitted on behalf of the prosecution and forward that material to the Registrar.
(b) Where such material includes an affidavit a copy of the affidavit must be served on the applicant or his or her personal representative. Service should be effected on the day the affidavit is filed with the Registrar.
(c) Where the Director of Public Prosecutor consents to the application, that fact must be conveyed to the Registrar in writing as soon as practicable.
(d) if within reasonable time, no more than three days after the filing of the application, the Registrar has not received any material submitted on behalf of the prosecution, the Registrar should report the matter to the Chief Justice who will then set a date for hearing.
6. Upon a hearing date being set, the Registrar will prepare an order to be signed by the Chief Justice which order will be served on the public officer in charge of the gaol for the delivery of the applicant at the time and date set for the hearing.
7. In a case where there are circumstances of urgency, the Registrar, upon receipt of the application outlining the grounds of urgency, must consult with the Chief Justice who may give directions to expedite or eliminate any of the above steps to ensure that the matter is dealt with urgently.
8. When the Chief Justice has made a decision the Registrar must promptly prepare an order for the signature of the Chief Justice and transmit the signed order to the police officer in charge of the gaol where the applicant is held. When the order contains conditions requiring the applicant to report to a police station, the Registrar must forthwith transmit copy of the order to the Commissioner of Police.
