Cabinet makes the following Regulations under *Section 36(2)(c)* of the *Maritime Security Act 2019*:

**1. Citation**

These Regulations may be cited as the *Maritime Security (Prohibition) Regulations 2020*.

**2. Commencement**

These Regulations come into effect on the day they are notified in the Gazette.

**3. Approaching or boarding ship without lawful authority**

(1) A person without the prior authorisation from customs, immigration, quarantine and the consent of the Harbourmaster shall not:

- (a) approach or board any ship in Nauru waters;
- (b) take or cause another person to take any material onto a ship in Nauru waters; or
- (c) remove or cause another person to remove any material from a ship in Nauru waters.

(2) No person shall aid or abet any person to contravene subregulation (1).

(3) A person who contravenes subregulation (1) or (2) commits an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 6 months or to both.
