MINISTERIAL SUBMISSION

AMENDMENT TO SCHOOL TERM DATES FOR 2022

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 This submission seeks ministerial endorsement to amend the school dates for the 2022 academic school year.

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 Due to the pandemic, schools in Nauru have been closed for up to nine weeks. For this reason, there is a need for extended dates to the school year to assist with the students' learning recovery.

2.2 Due to the uneven dates of school re-entry, year levels will be taking breaks at different times throughout the remainder of the year.

2.3 A subsequent proposal towards the end of the year may be required for an early return of students to the 2023 academic year.

PROPOSAL

3.1 Term 3 dates are extended into the school holidays and Term 4 is extended by one week into the Christmas holidays.

3.2 Publishing of new school term dates in the gazette as stipulated in Education Act (2011),

3.2.1 Section 13(1) 'The Minister may, by notice in the Gazette, prescribe the hours during which students are required to attend school.
