**REPUBLIC OF NAURU PUBLIC SERVICE ACT 2016 SUBDIVISION 10, SECTION 1,2 AND 3**  
**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS 2025**

**PURSUANT TO** the powers in that behalf vested in me under Section 81, subsection 1,2 & 3 of the Public Service Act 2016, the following days shall be observed officers and employees of the Public Service as Public Holidays for the year 2025.

Saturday 1 <sup>st</sup> February, 2025	Day following Independence Day
Saturday 8 <sup>th</sup> March 2025	International Womens Day
Friday 18 <sup>th</sup> April, 2025	Good Friday
Monday 21 <sup>st</sup> April, 2025	Easter Monday
Tuesday 22 <sup>nd</sup> April, 2025	Easter Tuesday
Saturday 17 <sup>th</sup> May, 2025	Constitution Day
Tuesday 1 <sup>st</sup> July, 2025	RONPHOS Handover
Tuesday 19 <sup>th</sup> August, 2025	Ibumin Earoeni Day
Thursday 25 <sup>th</sup> September, 2025	Sir Hammer DeRoburt Day
Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> October, 2025	Angam Day
Thursday 25 <sup>th</sup> December, 2025	Christmas Day
Friday 26 <sup>th</sup> December, 2025	Day following Christmas

Whenever a day specified in subsection (1) except Independence Day and Christmas Day, falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the following Monday is a holiday.

Whenever **Independence Day** and **Christmas Day**, falls on Saturday or a Sunday the following Monday and Tuesday are holidays.
