

# STATUTORY RULES.

No. 17 of 1939.

Made under the *Public Hospitals Ordinance*, 1911.

The *Public Hospital Rules*, 1923 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1923), are further amended as follows:—

1. By repealing Regulation 29 thereof and substituting the following in its stead:—

“*Radiographic Examination.*

29. Patients may be admitted purely for the purpose of radiographic examination and the charges made by Medical Officers to such patients and the conditions relating to such examination shall be set out in Schedule 1 of these rules.”

2. By omitting from Schedule 1 all the words following the end of Item (f) and inserting the following in their stead:—

“An amount equal to half such fees shall be paid to the Treasurer for the use of the apparatus by the Medical Officer on or before the close of the month on which such examination was made. Film to be the property of the patient. No fees to be charged to natives.”
