

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 18 of 1939.

Made under the *Public Hospitals Ordinance*, 1911.

The *Public Hospital Rules*, 1923 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1923), are further amended as follows:—

1. By inserting immediately after Regulation 18 the following new regulation:—

“18A. Out-patients treated at the hospital shall pay a sum of Two shillings for each day of attendance.”

2. By inserting immediately at the end of Regulation 19 the following words “In calculating the fees payable under this regulation the day of admission and the day of discharge shall be reckoned as one whole day.”

3. By inserting immediately after Regulation 19 the following new regulation:—

“19A. Members of the Defence Forces stationed in the Territory (not being local volunteers) shall not be required to pay any more than the daily maintenance fee.”

4. By adding at the end of the regulations the following new regulation and heading:—

“*Theatre and Anæsthetic fee.*”

30. Except as otherwise provided in these regulations every patient shall for any form of anæsthesia pay a fee of Ten shillings which fee shall cover both the cost of the anæsthetic and the preparation for its administration.”
