New Guinea.*

PROTECTION OF ANIMALS.

WHEREAS by section 5 of the *Birds and Animals Protection Ordinance 1922-1947 of the Territory of New Guinea*, it is amongst other things provided that the Administrator by Proclamation in the *Gazette* may declare that animals of any kind specified in the Proclamation shall be protected animals either without limitation as to time and place, or with such limitation as to time and place as he may specify:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to declare Trout (*Salmo trutta*), protected animals:

Now therefore, I, Jack Keith Murray, Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Birds and Animals Protection Ordinance 1922-1947 of the Territory of New Guinea* and all other powers me enabling, do hereby proclaim and declare Trout (*Salmo trutta*), to be protected animals in every place in the Territory from the date of this Proclamation.

Given under my Hand at Port Moresby, this third day of April, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, and in the fifteenth year of His Majesty's reign.
