## NOTICE MADE PURSUANT TO SECTION 3 OF THE BANK HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE, 1922-1937 ALTERING THE DATE OF A BANK HOLIDAY.

### NOTICE.<sup>(1)</sup>

*Bank Holidays Ordinance, 1922-1937, of the Territory of Papua.*

#### BANK HOLIDAY.

I THE ADMINISTRATOR of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, by virtue of the powers conferred by section 3 of the *Bank Holidays Ordinance, 1922-1937, of the Territory of Papua* and all other powers me enabling, hereby revoke the Notice dated the twenty-sixth day of July, 1949, and published in the *Gazette* No. 4 of the 3rd August, 1949, and I do hereby declare that the fourth day of September in any succeeding year, or the Monday following the fourth day of September in any succeeding year, shall not be a Bank Holiday and I do further declare that the following day in each succeeding year shall be a Bank Holiday instead of the day before-mentioned:—

1. The fifteenth day of September except when that day falls on a Saturday or Sunday or
2. Where the fifteenth day of September falls on a Saturday or Sunday the Monday immediately following.
