SANITARY DEPOT.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by regulations 33 and 43 of the Public Health (General Sanitation) Regulations of the Territory of New Guinea and all other powers me enabling, I, John Thomson Gunther, the Director of Public Health for the Territory of Papua-New Guinea, hereby establish the area set out in the Schedule hereto to be a nightsoil and refuse depot for the purposes of the said regulations.

SCHEDULE.

All that piece of land at Rapindik Gazelle Peninsula District of New Britain containing approximately 10 acres commencing at a point on the northern foreshore of Matupi Harbour at high-water mark equidistant from the two boiling springs at Rapindik aforesaid and bounded thence on the west by a straight line north to the Rapindik-Praed Point Road bounded thence on the north by part of the southern boundary of the aforesaid Rapindik-Praed Point Road generally easterly for approximately 1,140 links bounded thence on the east by a straight line south to the aforesaid northern foreshore of Matupi Harbour at high-water mark bounded thence on the south by the said northern foreshore of Matupi Harbour at high-water mark generally westerly to the point of commencement.
