

DOG ORDINANCE 1925.⁽¹⁾

No. 30 of 1925.

An Ordinance to repeal certain Ordinances relating to Dogs, and for other purposes.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Dog Ordinance 1925*.⁽¹⁾ Short title.

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three. Commencement.

3. The *Dog Ordinance 1916* and the *Dog (Amendment) Ordinance 1919* are hereby repealed: Repeal.

Provided that nothing in this Ordinance shall affect the validity of any registration made under those Ordinances prior to the commencement of this Ordinance.

4. Regulations 1, and 3 to 19 inclusive, of the *Dog Regulations 1923*,⁽²⁾ and the Schedules to those Regulations, shall be deemed to be as valid and effectual as if this Ordinance had been in force at the date upon which it is deemed to have commenced. Validation of regulations.
