

# FUGITIVE OFFENDERS (JURISDICTION) ORDINANCE 1927.<sup>(1)</sup>

No. 11 of 1927.

## An Ordinance to confer on the Central Court<sup>(2)</sup> jurisdiction under the Fugitive Offenders Act 1881 of the United Kingdom.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920-1926* as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Fugitive Offenders* Short title.  
(*Jurisdiction*) Ordinance 1927.<sup>(1)</sup>

2. The jurisdiction under Part I. of the *Fugitive Offenders Act* Central Court  
1881<sup>(3)</sup> of the United Kingdom (44 and 45 Vic. C. 69) to hear a to have
