Native Administration Regulations 1924.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by sub-regulation (6.) of regulation 80 of the Native Administration Regulations 1924, I, David Sydney Wanliss, the Deputy of the Administrator, do hereby direct that the provisions of regulation 80 of the Native Administration Regulations 1924 shall apply to the four areas specified in the Schedule hereto.

THE SCHEDULE.

Firstly—All that part of the District of New Britain situated within 805 metres of the Administration Sub-District Office at Talasea.

Secondly—All that part of the District of Morobe situated within 2600 metres of the Police Station at Edie Creek.

Thirdly—All that part of the District of Morobe situated within 2414 metres of the office of Bulolo Gold Dredging Limited at Bulolo.

Fourthly—All that part of the District of Morobe situated within 2414 metres of the office of Bulolo Gold Dredging Limited at Bulwa.

All that area being *firstly* the whole of Portion 75 in the Sepik District known as Angoram Administration Station containing 53 hectares 35 ares 44 square metres more or less and *secondly* the whole of a trading station containing approximately 85 ares situated on the south-east of and adjoining the south-eastern corner of Portion 75 aforesaid and *thirdly* the whole of a trading station containing approximately 30 ares situated on the north-west of and adjoining the westernmost corner of Portion 75 aforesaid.

NOTICE.

Native Administration Regulations 1924.

WHEREAS by regulation 128A of the Native Administration Regulations 1924 it is provided that the Administrator may, by notice in the *New Guinea Gazette*, declare any area specified in the notice to be an area in which any native, not being a native born in the area, shall not reside except in a village or place in which there resides a European who has immediate control over the native:

Now therefore I, Walter Ramsay McNicoll, the Administrator, do hereby declare every area which has been declared under section 4 of the *Uncontrolled Areas Ordinance* 1925-1935⁽¹⁾ to be, for the purposes of that Ordinance, an uncontrolled area, to be an area in which any native, not being a native born in the area, shall not reside except in a village or place in which there resides a European who has immediate control over the native.

NOTICE.

Native Administration Regulations 1924.

WHEREAS by regulation 128A of the Native Administration Regulations 1924 it is provided that the Administrator may, by notice in the *New Guinea Gazette*, declare any area specified in the notice to be an area in which any native, not being a native born in the area, shall not reside except in a village or place in which there resides a European who has immediate control over the native:

Now therefore I, Walter Ramsay McNicoll, the Administrator, do hereby declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be an area in which any native, not being a native born in the area, shall not reside except in a village or place in which there resides a European who has immediate control over the native.

THE SCHEDULE.

All that area being part of the District of Madang and comprising the southern slopes of Adelbert Range between the meridian 145 degrees of east longitude and the meridian 145 degrees 30 minutes of east longitude and including all those native groups known as Seseireka, Oposoku, Kossisim, Kababua, Motekulem, Motelau, Kilimitao, Avisau, Konakon, Kaikembababua, Atumburum, Abukia and Unima, and any native group within a radius of five miles from any of the said native groups.
