

NATIVES TAXES REGULATIONS.⁽¹⁾

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Natives Taxes Regulations*.⁽¹⁾ Short title.

2.—(1.) The person in charge of a mission school shall, within two months after the first day of January in each year, furnish to the District Officer administering the District in which the mission school is situated, returns in accordance with Forms A and B in the Schedule to these Regulations. Person in charge of mission school to furnish returns.

Penalty: Ten pounds.

(2.) Any person who wilfully makes a declaration incomplete or false in any material particular shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: Ten pounds.

(3.) No prosecution for an offence under this regulation shall be commenced without the authority in writing of the Director of District Services and Native Affairs.

3. For the purposes of section 13 of the *Natives Taxes Ordinance* 1921-1933,⁽²⁾ the following natives shall be prescribed natives:— Exemption from taxation under *Natives Taxes Ordinance* 1921-1933.

(a) Natives certified by a European member of a mission as being engaged in work relating to the spread of Christianity with the authority and on behalf of the mission; and R. 3 ad. by 1936, No. 9, r. 1; sub. by 1936, No. 21, r. 1.

(b) Natives in receipt of a pension under the Police Force Regulations.

4. The person in charge of a mission shall, within four months after the first day of January in each year, furnish, or cause to be furnished, to the District Officer administering the District in which natives, other than natives shown in a return under regulation 2 of these Regulations, are engaged in work relating to the spread of Chris- Person in charge of mission to furnish return of natives specified in paragraph (a) of regulation 3.
