*Customs Tariff (Amendment) Act 2003,*

Being an Act to amend the *Customs Tariff Act 1990,*

MADE by the National Parliament –

- (a) in respect of Paragraph (a), to come into operation in accordance with a notice in the National Gazette by the Head of State, acting on advice of the Minister; and
- (b) in respect of Paragraph (b), to be deemed to have come into operation on the coming into operation of the Principal Act.

**RATES OF IMPORT DUTY (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 1).**

Schedule 1 of the Principal Act is amended –

- (a) by repealing tariff item 2501.00.00 and replacing it with the following:-
