- 3. REPEAL AND REPLACEMENT OF SECTION 271.
 Section 271 of the Principal Act is repealed and replaced with the following new section:

"271. PROSECUTION OF OFFENCES.

With respect to offences created by this Act or any mandatory instrument, the Police may, in consultation with the Public Prosecutor and NICTA, carry out the prosecutions.".
